## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Illinois State Capitol Complex Menstrual Hygiene Product
- 6 Accessibility Act.
- 7 Section 5. Responsibility of the Secretary of State.
- 8 (a) The Office of the Secretary of State shall ensure that
- 9 menstrual hygiene products are provided, at no cost, in public
- 10 restrooms located within the Illinois State Capitol and the
- 11 William G. Stratton State Office Building.
- 12 (b) The Secretary of State shall:

ensure availability; and

- 13 (1) determine the appropriate locations for menstrual 14 product dispensers within the facilities;
- 15 (2) establish a maintenance and restocking schedule to
- 17 (3) oversee procurement, installation, and upkeep of
- dispensers in the designated facilities.
